ERIN'S - MAC AND "COTTAGE" CHEESE

INGREDIENTS

- 2 cups dried pasta of choice
- 1 cup cottage cheese
- 1/3 cup milk
- 1 cup shredded cheddar cheese
- 2 tablespoons pasta water
- 1 tablespoon cornstarch
- spices of choice: garlic powder, salt, pepper, onion powder and paprika Why cottage cheese?

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Cook your pasta according to the package. Drain and set aside but do not forget to save some pasta water
- 2. In a blender, combine cottage cheese, shredded cheese, milk, and spices of choice and blend until smooth.
- 3.In a small bowl, whisk your reserved pasta water and cornstarch until combined.
- 4. Add your cheese sauce to a small pan over medium heat and bring it to a simmer. Add the cornstarch + water mixture to the sauce and continuously stir. Cook until the sauce begins to thicken- about 5 minutes.
- 5. Add pasta to the sauce, stir and enjoy!

(Add cooked vegetables on the side to boost the nutritional value of this meal)


